 - Social He brings an end to labels and titles that people think elevate them
 - Economic The rich sold their riches so the poor could have the basic necessities of life
 - (vv. 54-55) God's Faithfulness in Sending Psalm 98; Luke 1:5-25; FRI: Luke 1:26-38
 - Have you missed God's blessing/promise because you're too impatient to wait?
 - Are you as faithful to God as He is to you?
 - How can we as the "church" model Christ values? Romans 15:1-13
