Process for Updating Water & Sewer Service on Private Property

If you plan to replace the portion of the water or sewer service line on your property you should contact a licensed plumber to get a cost estimate for the work. You will also need to secure a contractor for any excavation. The replacement of the portion of the water or sewer service line on your property is not required. You may continue to use your existing service line on your property and the new service line from the street will be connected to it.

Process

- 1. Secure a licensed plumber to do the work. Secure a permit from CEO Stanley Hackett (207-793-2166 Ext 5).
- 2. Have your plumber co-ordinate with your contractor for excavation of service from your property line to your building.
- 3. Excavation from your property line to your building is the property owner's responsibility.
- 4. The plumbing work will require access to your building.
- 5. Co-ordinate with the Limerick Water and Sewer District Trustees

Estimated Construction Schedule

The Hollandville Project begins 4/24/2023

Construction will begin on Wescott Street first, then Maple Street.

Construction on Prospect Street is expected to start around the third week of July.
