A current physical must be on file for all returning athletes, and a doctor's clearance must be turned in for all new athletes or rising 9<sup>th</sup> graders to participate in tryouts. All athletes that are placed on a squad will need to obtain a NEW physical dated <u>AFTER April 1<sup>st</sup></u> on the 2021-2022 Cobb County Physical Form AND upload it to Synergy ParentVue before they are permitted to participate in any events, conditioning, etc. This is COBB COUNTY policy.

#### **Tryout Process and Team Selection**

Tryouts are MANDATORY. The only exception is for those students that are involved in a spring sport at Lassiter. Rising freshman should NOT check out of school early to attend tryouts.

The selection process will be a weeklong evaluation and will include a timed mile run.

#### Clinic Attire:

- Athletic Shorts and T shirt or Tank Top
- Cheerleading Shoes
- DO NOT WEAR JEWELRY TO CLINIC OR TRYOUT
- HAIR MUST BE WORN UP, NAILS MUST BE TRIMMED and NO GUM.

#### **Tryout Attire:**

- Black Shorts (No Nike Pro/Spandex Shorts) and Plain White T Shirt- Must be Tucked in
- Cheerleading Shoes
- HAIR MUST BE WORN UP, NO JEWELRY, NO LONG NAILS, NAIL COLOR MUST BE LIGHT IN COLOR, NO GUM

#### Each cheerleader candidate will be scored based on the criteria detailed below:

- Cheer: Motion technique and sharpness
- Dance: Timing, rhythm and motion technique
- Jumps: Toe touch and a learned jump sequence
- Standing Tumbling
- Running Tumbling
- Stunting Ability
- Crowd Appeal: Showmanship and genuine spirit
- Sportsmanship: Attitude and participation during tryouts
- Overall Technique
- Appearance: Correct clothing and hair pulled back off the shoulders (in a ponytail)

While the coaches are looking for candidates with a great deal of ability, we are also looking for candidates who have the potential to form a squad.

In the event a candidate is injured at the time of tryouts, coaches' discretion will be used in considering him/her for selection as a cheerleader.

State rules concerning school attendance will be followed. You must be at school for four periods to participate in tryouts that day. This is applied to minimum-day students as well.

Those selected for a squad are expected to maintain skills. Athletes should be able to perform not only during tryouts but also in practices, games, and as a part of a routine. **Failure to do so will lead to probation and possible dismissal from the team.** 

The cheerleading coaches will make the final decision for membership on a squad.

FRESHMAN Football/Basketball Squad: Freshman are eligible to cheer on this squad. They will cheer at Freshman football and Freshman/JV basketball games. They are also required to attend Varsity football games to sell programs (Pending due to Covid). Tumbling is not required, but athletes are expected to be working on tumbling.

- JUNIOR VARSITY(JV) Football/Varsity Basketball Squad: Sophomores and Juniors are eligible to cheer on this squad. They will cheer all JV football and Varsity basketball games, tournaments, and post-season play\*. Tumbling is not required, but athletes are expected to be working on tumbling.
- JUNIOR VARSITY(JV) Competition Squad: Freshman, Sophomores, and Juniors are eligible to cheer on this squad. They will compete in four competitions in addition to cheering with their respective football squads (Pending due to numbers). Tumbling is required; athletes must have or be working on a standing back handspring or roundoff back handspring.
- VARSITY Competition/Varsity Football: All grades are eligible to cheer on the Varsity Competition Squad. This squad will cheer all football games during the regular season and post-season\* play. The Competition Squad will compete during the entire competition season, Region Competition, and State Competition\*\*. Tumbling is required, athletes must have or be working on Standing Tuck and Roundoff Backhandspring Tuck/ Roundoff Tuck. Region and State are November 6th and November 12th-13th, respectively. Region and State competitions take place during the regular football cheering season. Competition practices and events take priority over sideline cheering. GHSA, not coaches, mandate when these events occur.
- VARSITY Football/VARSITY Basketball Squad: Juniors and Seniors are eligible to cheer on the Varsity Football/Basketball Squad. This squad will represent Lassiter by cheering all Varsity football and basketball games, tournaments, and post-season play\*. Tumbling is required. Athletes must have a standing back handspring on the dead floor and on the track.
- VARSITY Competition: All grades are eligible to cheer Varsity Competition only. This squad will compete during the entire competition season, Region and State (same as above)\*\*. If you choose to tryout for competition only, you cannot change your mind and be added to FB or BB. Tumbling is required, athletes must have or be working on Standing Tuck and Roundoff Backhandspring Tuck/ Roundoff Tuck.
- VARSITY BASKETBALL ONLY- Open to all 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> graders. This squad will represent Lassiter by cheering all HOME Varsity basketball games, tournaments, and post-season play\*. No tumbling is required.

## LASSITER HIGH SCHOOL - CHEERLEADING POLICIES

#### **PURPOSE**

The purpose of the Lassiter High School Cheerleading Program is to promote and uphold school spirit, develop a sense of good sportsmanship among students, and strive for better relationships between schools during athletic events.

#### **GENERAL OBJECTIVES**

Cheerleaders are student athletes and must strive to achieve the highest standards both academically and physically. Cheering at Lassiter High School is a privilege, NOT a right.

#### **SQUADS**

Cheerleaders will report directly to their coach for all matters. Cheerleaders are "on the job" all year long. Cheerleaders are often asked to assist in school functions and activities other than the seasonal sport. These functions are mandatory.

#### **UNIFORMS**

Uniforms are provided to cheerleaders by Lassiter High School and are property of the school. If a uniform does not fit, it may be altered <u>BUT NOT CUT</u> at the cheerleader's expense. The alternations must NOT be permanent to the uniform, and the uniform could be returned to its prealtered state prior to returning the uniform. If the uniform is returned in an unusable condition, the cheerleader will pay to have the uniform replaced. (Estimated cost \$350)

Note: Returning cheerleaders are NOT guaranteed the same uniform in consecutive seasons.

#### **BEHAVIOR AND DISCIPLINE**

As a member of the Lassiter Cheerleading Program, you are expected to maintain behavior above reproach because you are a student athlete and a leader in the school. Consequences for violating any regulation in this constitution will be at the discretion of the coach and will be handled according to the rules of Lassiter High School, the Georgia High School Association (GHSA), and Cobb County policy. Please keep in mind the following:

- Any behavior which is deemed by the coach as reflecting poorly on the intended image of the program- no matter where the incident takes place- is subject to dismissal from the program at the coach's discretion. This includes, but is not limited to, pictures on Social Media, wearing uniform in public without coach's permission, inappropriate behavior in public (even if not in a Lassiter High School uniform or practice clothes).
- <u>Cheerleaders who receive ISS</u> will not be allowed to participate in any cheerleading activity during the suspension period.
- <u>Cheerleaders who receive OSS</u> will not be allowed to participate in any cheerleading activity during the suspension period and will be subject to dismissal from the program at the coaches' discretion.

#### **TRANSPORTATION**

Cheerleaders will travel to and from football games and competitions by bus when the school provides a bus. Some exceptions may be made for competitions.

#### **ELIGIBILITY**

All cheerleaders MUST...

- Pass five out of six classes each semester and be on track academically towards graduation at the end of the year
- If a cheerleader quits or is terminated, he/she will not be allowed to tryout the next year or attend the end of the year banquet. Exceptions to this may be granted at the coaches' discretion.

#### **VARSITY LETTERS**

To be eligible for a varsity letter, a cheerleader must be on a **Varsity Squad** (Football, Basketball, or Competition) and meet the following requirement:

- The athlete must complete the entire season. Those dismissed from the program for any reason will not receive a letter.
- In ADDITION, the coach must recommend the cheerleader for their letter. This means that the cheerleader must demonstrate a positive attitude, work well with their teammates, be respectful, and give 100% all the time. **ALL coaches' decisions are final.**

#### **ATTENDANCE POLICIES**

As members of the Lassiter Cheerleading Program, you are required to contribute your part. When one person is absent, the whole squad suffers and causes ineffective practice time. As a result, the following attendance rules are necessary and will be enforced:

- Cheerleaders must schedule appointments and work schedules around all cheerleading activities. Note: duties are often scheduled with little advance notice. Early release from or late arrival to practices and performances is unacceptable.
- Cheerleaders must be present at all practices, performances, fundraisers, pep rallies, sign painting sessions, camps, competitions, and any other activities designated by the coach.
- Excused absences are:
  - Death in the family
  - o Signed doctor's excuse that indicates time and date of sickness or injury
  - School-related trips or performances
  - Any other excused absences are at the discretion of the coach and will be addressed on an individual basis. All absences MUST be approved by the coach at least 24 hours prior to the missed practice, game, competition, or event.
  - If a cheerleader is seen by a doctor for an injury that affects his/her ability to cheer, a signed doctor's note must be submitted to the coach and will also be required for the cheerleader to participate once healthy.
  - As a high school athlete, it is the responsibility of the CHEERLEADER to communicate directly with the coaching staff regarding any attendance issues.

#### **COMMUNITY SERVICE**

Cheerleaders are expected to participate in community service that directly impacts the Lassiter High School Community. This includes, but is not limited to, canned food drives, 5k runs, and other service opportunities. \*\* Pending due to COVID\*\*

## PARTICIPANT APPAREL/ACCESSORIES (National Federation High School Spirit Rules Book)

These are rules by which all schools in the state are required to abide.

- Art. 1... A coach must not permit a team member to participate if, in the judgment of the coach, the participant does not conform to the NFHS rules.
- Art. 2... Jewelry must not be worn except for religious medals, which shall be taped to the body (without a chain) under the uniform.

(This includes ALL piercings. It is acceptable to use a plastic plug to prevent holes from closing up. New piercings are vulnerable at practices when we are stunting. Since jewelry is not allowed, piercings should be done in the off-season. Covering an earring with a bandage is NOT acceptable.)

- Art. 3... Unduly long fingernails, including artificial nails, can become a safety hazard. Therefore, fingernails, including artificial nails, must be kept at a length appropriate to minimize risk for the participants. (In addition, only clear or light color polish can be worn at games/competitions/events.)
- Art. 4... The hair must be worn in a manner to minimize risk for the participant. (Ex. Off the shoulders)
- Art. 6... Glitter ...on one's ...hair, face, uniform, costume or body is illegal.
- Art. 8... Participants are not permitted to chew gum or have candy in their mouths during practice or performance.

#### VOLUNTEERING

Our program depends 100% on volunteers. Parent/ guardians are required to select a volunteer activity/ position for both Camp Lassiter and the Competition held by Lassiter in the Fall. In addition, the program requires a parent/ guardian of each cheerleader to participate in 1 volunteer committee activity per season (football/ basketball/comp). Please bring a check for \$200 (for any two-season athlete) or \$100 (for basketball or comp only) payable to Trojan Cheer Booster Club to the Post Tryout Meeting. This check will not be cashed unless the volunteer requirements are not met by the end of the cheer season in March 2022.

#### FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITIES

Every attempt will be made to cut down on the personal costs to the cheerleaders. Every cheerleader is REQUIRED to participate in fundraising events. **All fees are non-refundable**. If a cheerleader quits or is removed for any reason, a refund cannot be issued. Scheduled fundraisers include but are not limited to Camp Lassiter Cheer Camp, Corporate Sponsorships, Percentage Nights, Snap! Raise, and Lassiter Cheerleading Competition.

All cheerleaders are expected to participate in the Snap! Raise crowdfunding fundraiser by creating a profile and adding 20 email addresses prior to the Post Tryout Meeting. More information will be sent about this after tryout, prior to the Post Tryout Meeting. Our goal is that each cheerleader will raise \$500. This money will be used to cover our costs to attend a UCA/ NCA camp this summer and program expenses. If you choose not to participate in this fundraiser, you will have to cover your camp costs (\$250) in addition to the payment schedule fees. For cheerleaders who meet the \$500 fundraising goal, \$100 will be credited to their individual program costs. Cheerleaders who raise \$1,000 or more will have \$300 credited towards their individual program costs.

All items below are mandatory- if you cheered for LHS last year and already have the items on the list, you do not need to order them again. Please note that all prices are approximate and do not include tax, etc.

## LASSITER HIGH SCHOOL EXPLANATION OF INHERENT RISKS FOR CHEERLEADING



## Cheerleader Candidate's Full Name:

| Cheerleading is an exciting, time-consuming sport that involves flyers, bases, and spotters. Flyers are lifted into stunts by the bases, with the safety-oriented spotters when needed. Bases and spotters are responsible for catching the flyers when the stunts come down. Cheerleading also requires forceful motions, tumbling, voice projection and jumping. The cheering area varies greatly from one location to another, inside or outside. Because of these conditions inherent to the sport, participating in cheerleading exposes an athlete to many risks of injury. Those injuries include but are not limited to: death, paralysis due to serious neck and back injuries, brain damage, damage to internal organs, serious injuries to the bones, ligaments, joints, and tendons, and general deterioration of health. Such injuries can result not only in temporary loss of function but also in serious impairment of future physical, psychological, and social abilities, including the ability to earn a living. In an effort to make cheerleading as safe as it can be, the coaching staff will instruct athletes concerning the correct techniques for stunts and rules of cheerleading. It is vital that athletes follow the coach's skill instructions, training rules, and team policies to decrease the possibility of serious injury. |


