FIRE SEASON CONTINUES!

Please call **911 immediately if you see or suspect a wildfire**. Shelter Cove Fire wants to stress how important it is for you to make the 911 call immediately. Even if you are not sure what you are seeing is a wildfire dial 911. Catching a fire as early as possible is critical as local volunteer fire department resources are limited and aerial support/heavy equipment assistance takes time to respond to our remote location.

Please do not stack limbs over 5 feet high – just start a new pile. Tree trunks, stumps, rotten wood, rocks, and garbage cannot be chipped. Shelter Cove Airport/Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan/Community Meeting:

Recently you may have seen, read and/or heard multiple emails & social media posts concerning the Shelter Cove Airport and the new Humboldt County - 2021 Airport Land Use Compatibility Plan (ALUCP).

The Board of Supervisors as the Humboldt County Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC) approved the 2021 ALUCP in April of this year. State law requires that the ALUC rely upon the guidance provided in the Caltrans Handbook or California Airport Land Use Planning as the starting point for compatibility planning around airports.

To better help residents and property owners understand the new ALUCP in Shelter Cove and to provide an opportunity for individuals and business interests to ask questions directly to Humboldt County Planning & Building Department staff members there will be an online public meeting on Wednesday October 6th from 5PM to 7PM. RID staff and our 2nd District supervisor Michelle Bushnell will also be participating in the meeting.
