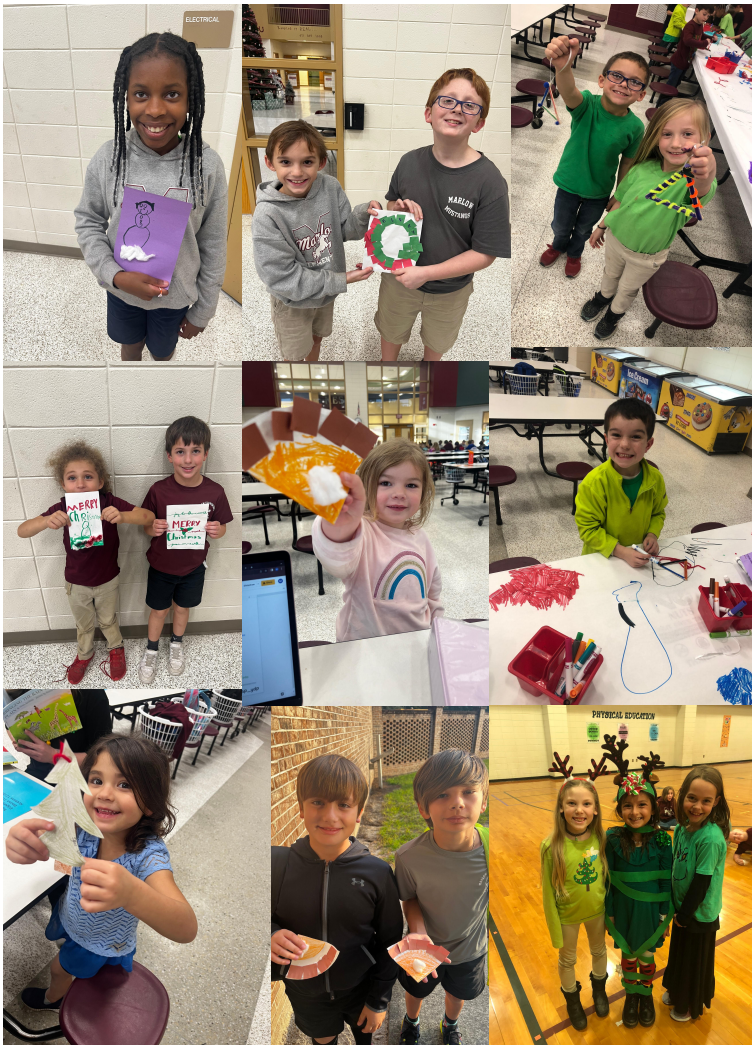

Backpack Buddies



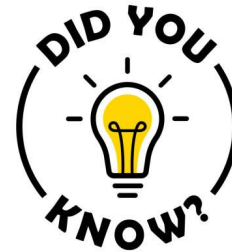
Backpack buddies is a non-profit program dedicated to supporting the children of Effingham County, who have a need of food on the weekends.
