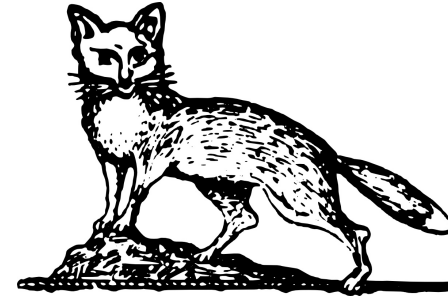

### SCHOOLING BREAK

## CLASS SPECIFICATIONS (con't)

**SWVHJA PRE-BEGINNER EQUITATION** – Open to junior and amateur riders in first year of showing over fences less than 2' in height. Riders are eligible for one horse show year and may not enter divisions with fence heights of 2' or above. To be judged on rider's position and control. Division may be combined with the Beginner Equitation division at Management's discretion if entries warrant. Fences 18". No oxers.

**SWVHJA BEGINNER EQUITATION** – Open to junior and amateur riders in first year of showing over fences 2' in height. No oxers. Riders eligible for one horse show year and may not enter divisions with fence heights over 2'. This division will not count against rider's 2-year eligibility for the Intermediate Hunter division. Judged on rider's position and control. Division may be split between juniors and adults at the discretion of show management.

**PONY MEDAL** - Open to current junior members of SWVHJA mounted on ponies. To be shown over a minimum of 6 jumps at the appropriate heights. Martingales may not be used in the flat phase. Each phase to count 50%. The same pony must be used for both phases. Four entries are required to fill the class with a minimum of three to complete the class. If no Pony Medal is offered, a rider may compete on a pony in the Hunter Seat Medal. A rider cannot compete in both the Pony and the Hunter Seat Medals in one show, nor can they participate in both aforementioned finals in one year.

**SMALL/MEDIUM PONY HUNTER** - Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Ponies shown in this division may not be shown by an adult in any recognized division at the same horse show. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Small ponies (not to exceed 12.2h) to jump 2', medium ponies (over 12.2h - not to exceed 13.2h) to jump 2'3". Divisions must be offered split, but if there are not three ponies in either the Small/Medium or Large Pony divisions, the divisions must be combined. Lines less than 72' must be set on appropriate distances.

**LARGE PONY HUNTER** - Open to ponies ridden by juniors. Ponies shown in this division may not be shown by an adult in any recognized division at the same horse show. Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Large ponies (over 13.2h - not to exceed 14.2h) to jump 2'6". Divisions must be offered split, but if there are not three ponies in either the Small/Medium or Large Pony divisions, the divisions must be combined. Lines less than 72' must be set on appropriate distances.

**RANDOLPH COLLEGE MEDAL** – Open to junior and amateur riders on horses or ponies who have not qualified for a SWVHJA Medal class or the Oak Ridge Medal during the current show year. Class consists of two phases judged 50% each. First phase will be not less than 8 fences at 2'6", may not contain a combination. Course must contain two changes of direction after the first fence. Second phase shall be ridden on the flat at a walk, trot, and canter both directions. Judges may test from USEF 1 – 10. Martingales permitted in the flat phase. The same horse must be used for both phases.

**SPECIAL ADULT HUNTER** - Open to Adult Amateur riders on horses or ponies. Fences 2'6" or 2'9". Both heights must be offered and judged together. Distances between two jumps no less than 60' (4 strides). Judged on performance, manners, way of going. Horse/rider combination cannot compete over fences over 2'9" at the same show. Special Adult Hunter division and Special Children's Hunter division may be combined if entries warrant.

**SPECIAL CHILDREN'S HUNTER** - Same specs as the Special Adult Hunter, except open to junior riders.

**GREEN HUNTER** - Open to horses in their first or second year of showing over fences at 2'6" or higher prior to the current competition year. To be eligible for green status, horses may not have shown over fences 2'6" or higher the previous year. Fences 2'6" and 3'. Both heights must be offered and judged together.

**LOW HUNTER** - Open to horses and ponies. To be judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fences 3'.

**CHILDREN'S HUNTER** - Open to juniors mounted on horses. Judged on performance, manners, way of going. Fences 3'. Management may combine division with the Adult Amateur Hunter division if entries warrant.

**ADULT AMATEUR HUNTER** - Open to adult amateur riders mounted on horses or ponies. To be judged on performance, manners and way of going. Ponies shown by an adult may not be shown in the Pony Hunter division at the same horse show. Fences 3'. Management may combine division with the Children's Hunter division if entries warrant.

**HOPEFUL HUNTER** - Open to horses and ponies. Judged on performance, manners, way of going. Fences 2'3".

**PLEASURE HUNTER** - Open to horses and ponies. To be judged on performance, manners and way of going. Fences 2'.

**INTERMEDIATE HUNTER** - Open to juniors and adult amateurs in their first or second year of showing, on horses or ponies, excluding the Beginner Equitation division. Fences 2'3". Riders who show at 2'6" or above in their first year forfeit a second Intermediate year. To be judged on performance, manners, and way of going. The rider may not jump higher than 2'6" at the same horse show.

## CLASS SPECIFICATIONS

### JUMPER DIVISIONS

**PUDDLE JUMPERS** – Table IV-Open to horses/ponies ridden by amateurs/professional exhibitors 0.70m= Fences 2'3".

**NOVICE JUMPERS** – Table IV-Open to horses/ponies in 1st or 2nd year of showing in jumper classes at .75m or higher as of December 1st of current show year.

**NOVICE CHILDREN'S/ADULT JUMPERS** –Table IV- Open to children/adult amateurs in first or second year of showing in jumper classes at 0.75m or higher as of December 1st of the current competition year. Riders in this division may only cross enter into Novice Jumper, if eligible and Low Jumper at the same show. This division shall be no lower than 0.70m and no higher than 0.75m. All classes should be offered under Table IV. If holding a VHSA Association show, the VHSA division names must be used on the results.

**TRAINING JUMPERS** - Open to horses/ponies ridden by amateurs/professional exhibitors. 0.80m= Fences 2'7".

**LOW JUMPERS** – This division shall be no lower than 0.75m in height and not greater than 0.90m in height. Spreads shall be no greater than the height of the fence. All classes offered under Table IV. If holding a VHSA Association show, the VHSA division names must be used on the results.

**CHILDREN'S/ADULT JUMPER** – Open to horses/ponies ridden by a junior or adult amateur exhibitor.

Fences .95 to 1.05 meters. USEF Tables I – IV may be used.

**LEVEL 2 JUMPER** – Fences .95 – 1.0 meters. USEF Tables I – IV may be used– Fences over 1.0 – 1.10 meters. USEF Tables I – IV may be used.

### Hunter Divisions

**SWVHJA HUNTER SEAT MEDAL** - Open to riders who have not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the calendar year. To be shown over a course of fences not to exceed 3' that must include two changes of direction, a combination and at least three oxers. Martingales may not be used in the flat phase. Each phase to count 50%. Same horse must be used for both phases. Four entries required to fill the class with a minimum of three to complete the class. If entries warrant, class can be combined with the Adult Medal.

**SWVHJA ADULT MEDAL** - Same specs as for the SWVHJA Hunter Seat Medal Class, except open to amateur riders 18 years of age and older. Ponies may be ridden by adults, but may not be shown in the Pony Hunter division at the same horse show. If there are fewer than four entries, this class can be combined with the Hunter Seat Medal. SWVHJA Adult Medal contestants may compete throughout the year. The top twenty (20) point earners, with a minimum of 10 points, will be invited to compete in the Adult Medal Finals.

**JUNIOR EQUITATION ON THE FLAT 14 & Under** - Open to riders who have not reached their 15th birthday by December 1st of the calendar year. Same specs as Jr. Eq on the Flat 15 – 17.

**JUNIOR EQUITATION ON THE FLAT 15-17** - Open to riders who have reached their 15th birthday by

December 1st of the calendar year, but not reached their 18th birthday as of December 1st of the calendar year. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control, and guidance. USEF tests 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. Riders need not be members of SWVHJA to compete. If there are insufficient entries, this class may be combined with the Junior Equitation on the Flat 14 & under and/or the Adult Equitation on the flat.

**ADULT EQUITATION ON THE FLAT** - Open to amateurs 18 years of age and older. To be shown at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring and judged on position, control, and guidance. USEF tests 1-19 may be used, excluding those requiring work over fences. Three entries are necessary to fill this class. Riders need not be members of SWVHJA to compete. If there are insufficient entries, this class may be combined with the Junior Equitation on the flat. Riders must stay within their age group if classes are split by age.

**ADULT HUNTER PLEASURE HORSE** - Open to horses shown with hunter tack on the flat ridden by an Adult. Classes to be offered are: Walk/Go As You Please, Walk/Trot, and Walk/Trot/Canter. No over fences classes will count toward this division. If entries warrant, the Hunter Pleasure Pony division may be combined with the Junior Hunter Pleasure division and the Adult Hunter Pleasure Horse division. To be judged on manners, suitability, and way of going. For year end points to accrue, three entries must enter and compete in all three classes of the division.

**JUNIOR HUNTER PLEASURE HORSE** – Same specs as the Adult Hunter Pleasure Horse except open to junior riders.

**HUNTER PLEASURE PONY** - Open to ponies shown with hunter tack on the flat ridden by a Junior. Same specs as the Adult Hunter Pleasure Horse except open to junior riders.

## BRIDGEWATER COLLEGE EQUESTRIAN CENTER

### General Rules and Information

1. Upon arrival at the BCEC, all participants MUST check in at the Stable Office.
2. **A negative coggins must be provided for every horse brought onto the grounds and turned into the Stable Office (state law). Horses coming from out of state are required have a health certificate (federal law).**
3. **NO SMOKING IN INDOOR ARENA OR BARN. THIS IS THE LAW.**
4. **VEHICLES:** Drive carefully. Obey all parking directions and traffic signs. Speed limits strictly enforced. Every vehicle must have a valid driver's license and proof of insurance. Vehicles are permitted only if operated in a safe manner (VA state law).
5. No trash or sharps in manure pits or stalls. Sharps should be placed in red boxes in barns and not in trashcans.
6. **DOGS/PETS:** No dogs. No exceptions. College policy enforced.
7. Any loss, theft, accident or disturbance should be reported to the BCEC. Lost and Found is located in the Show Office.
8. No firearms or fireworks are permitted.
9. The Glenmore Hunt Pony Club and Bridgewater College shall be held harmless against all claims, costs, losses or liability of the every nature and kind asserted against or incurred by visitor arising or resulting in any respect from visitor's occupancy and use of premises.

### ENTRIES

- Entry Fees: \$16 per class, \$20 medal classes. \$25 non-showing horse fee.
- If possible, exhibitors are asked to leave an open check rather than cash. \$15 for entries not closed out.
- All exhibitors must show at the Show Office a copy of current negative coggins report taken within one year for each horse admitted onto the show grounds.
- Equine Activity Release/Waiver on the Entry Form must be signed by all exhibitors or by a parent/guardian of minor exhibitors.
- Approve helmets must be worn when mounted.
- Six ribbons will be awarded in each class. Champion and Reserve ribbons awarded in all divisions.
- A limited number of stalls are available Friday afternoon, after 2:00 p.m. Stall fees are \$40per day/night and reservations must be sent into Shannon Boyer sob001@bridgewater.edu before noon Wed., May 15<sup>th</sup>, 2019.
- Tack stall splits are only available if done on the entry blank in advance. Please note that the total may exceed 100%.
- Pre-entries are recommended and should be sent to Diane Hinch, 44 Windy Grove Lane, Fishersville, VA 22939 postmarked by May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2019 or enter electronically at Horse Shows Online.

- The Horse Show Office will be located in the Indoor Ring and will be open one hour before the start of the show and will remain open until the close of the show.
- Show management reserves the right to have a controlled schooling break.

- Schooling will be permitted on Friday, May 17, 2019 from 4:30 – 6:00 p.m.
