## PUTNAM COUNTY MEDICAL MISSION

This program truly reaches the needs of people in our community. Volunteers are still needed. There are still lots of ways for you to participate. Prayer Team: Add PCMM to your daily prayer list. Phone Support: Answer the clinic calls remotely, provide basic information and send messages as needed. Receptionist: Greet patients. Eligibility Specialist: Become certified by the Health Department to complete eligibility paperwork. Office Support: Assist with patient data entry into the electronic medical record; assist with patient sign out procedures, other office needs. Medical Assistant / Nurse: Provide patient care triage and assist Provider as needed. Staff arrives at 3pm for set up. Come by, check it out and join in the mission. The Putnam County Medical Missions offers services for primary medical care, diagnostic, referrals, prescriptions and help with pharmaceutical programs. They hope to continue to grow according to the needs of the community by staffing each clinic with 2 more providers to be open weekly. They still have a need for Volunteer Providers (Medical Doctor, Physician Assistant, Advanced Registered Nurse Practitioner), visible signs and financial donations. In the month of August 2018 the Palatka location was open 2 days seeing patients with 9 volunteers, 41.50 volunteer hours providing \$1290.00 in services for the month. Our year to date totals so far is 16 clinic days with 89 patient visits, 416.50 volunteer hours providing \$13473.00 in services.
