FAN CLUB MEMBERSHIP!

AFTER MUCH THOUGHT and deliberation, we have come to the difficult conclusion that it will be necessary to start charging a fan club membership fee. These last two newsletters have been gladly sent with no fee required because Juice wanted to say 'thank you' for your wonderful loyalty and support over the years. But she began to realize that we cannot provide the items you so rightly deserve as loyal fans without charging a fee. So, beginning July 1, 1985, the annual membership fee for the Juice Newton Fan Club will be \$5.00 in the U.S., \$6.00 in Canada, and \$7.00 overseas. These fees will cover the time period of 7/1/85 to 7/1/86. To those fans who have families with one or more children, the annual fee for *the whole family* will be \$5.00, and will entitle you to the quarterly newsletter and an autographed photo of Juice. If photos are wanted for each child in the family there will be a charge of \$1.00 per photo. For those who wish to join (and we hope you all do!), simply return the enclosed application for membership together with check or money order...no cash, please. In return, after August 1st, you will receive a packet containing the following: A membership card, a biography of Juice, an autographed 8X10 photo, an update on record and tour information, and an attractive pin. When the new album is released later this year, we hope to make available full-sized poster of Juice. We sincerely hope that this fee will not work a hardship on anyone and trust that everyone will be able to remain in the Juice Newton Fan Club!

ADOPT-AN-EAGLE PROGRAM

JUICE HAS JOINED the Tennessee Adopt-An-Eagle program, the first of its kind in the U.S. Others who have joined are: Neil Young, Waylon Jennings, Michael Martin Murphy, Johnny Cash, John Anderson, Rosanne Cash, Eddy Arnold, William Lee Golden, just to name a few! Each artist adopts an eagle and gives him (or her!) a name. Juice has named her eagle APPOLO. 'Save the Eagle Productions' raises money to save America's eagles, which are our nation's symbol of freedom, through a coordinated music project that markets a 50 song country album. Among the artists present on the 5-record set are: Juice (of course!), Waylon Jennings, Jerry Reed, Neil Young, Wm. Lee Golden, John Anderson and many, many more. Look for it!

Juice will be appearing in Atlantic City, on the Boardwalk, at CLARIDGE'S CASINO on July 12th and 13th, 2 shows each night!
