2 tbsp olive oil	1 tbsp maple syrup		
1/3 cup pure pumpkin puree	1 tsp minced garlic		
½ tsp salt	¹ / ₄ tsp dried thyme leaves		
¹ / ₄ tsp cinnamon			
For the Salad:			
1 acorn squash roasted to your liking	1 apple, thinly sliced		
¹ / ₂ cup toasted pecans	¹ / ₄ cup dried cranberries		

1 pkg. 5-6 ounces mixed salad greens

FOR THE DRESSING:

Place all ingredients in a blender and combine. Chill until ready to use.

ASSEMBLE THE SALAD:

Once the squash has cooled, cut it into bite-sized pieces and place it in a large salad bowl with the remaining ingredients. Add Pumpkin Dressing and toss gently. Serve immediately.
