**#1 Discovering Hope Amid Despair** - For some, the journey began amidst moments of profound despair and hopelessness. *We need to share the hope of Christ.* 

**#2 Finding Comfort in Prayer** - Some found their way back to Christianity through the solace of prayer during times of personal struggle. *We need to pray for them and with them.* 

**#3 Embracing Community and Literature** - The allure of community and the wisdom found in Christian literature played pivotal roles in guiding some individuals towards faith. *We need to surround them with the love of our Christian community.* 

**#4 Encountering God's Love and Presence** - Whether through interactions at a bible camp or moments of worship, the palpable presence of God ignited a profound spiritual awakening, reshaping their outlook on life and identity. *Invite them to church activities.* 

**#5 Witnessing Miracles and Divine Intervention** - Some were swayed by firsthand experiences of divine intervention and providence. *Share your miracles with them.* 

**#6 Reconciling Science and Spirituality** - The reconciliation of science and spirituality paved the way for others to embrace Christianity. *Give them resources they need.* 

**#7 Exploring Philosophical and Existential Questions -** Wrestling with questions about the origins of the universe and the nature of existence led to a profound openness to spirituality. *Again, point them to resources they need.* 

**#8 Rediscovering Meaning and Purpose** - The teachings of the Bible provided practical guidance on morality and citizenship, while the assurance of God's presence offered comfort and reassurance in uncertain times. *Encourage them to read the Bible.* 

May we continue to pray for the non-Christ followers in our lives and be encouraged. In Christ Alone.

On Good Friday from 12:00 to 3:00 PM


the sanctuary will be open for anyone to come and pray. Feel free to come and pray for as long as the Spirit leads you.




IMO cofounders, Bola and Aimee Adebisi will be visiting with us on Easter Sunday.
