### Required Tools for Indentured Apprentices **INSIDE WIREMAN**

- Tool Box or Bag (Large enough to contain listed tools)
- Electricians Tool Pouch and Belt
- 2 Pair Channel Lock Pliers, #420 or equivalent (Grooved, not slip joint type)
- Pliers, 9" (Klein side-cutting type)
- Hacksaw Frame with Blade Storage
- Claw Hammer – Fiberglass or metal handle
- 2 Straight Screw Drivers (one 4" x 3/16) and (one 6" x 1/4)
- 2 Phillips Screw Drivers (one #2 x 4") and (one #3 x 6")
- 6 Foot Wooden Folding Rule (Klein or Lufkin type **inside reading**)
- Pocket Knife
- Pliers, 6" Long-nose (needle-nose)
- Pliers, 8" Diagonal cutting
- Center Punch (medium size)
- Scratch Awl (solid metal or metal through handle)
- Crescent Wrench, 10" adjustable wrench
- 1 Voltage Tester (non-adjustable, Klein-ET100 or equivalent)
- Chalk line box (Plumb Bob Type)
- Flashlight (2-cell)
- Torpedo Level, 9" magnetic
- Pencil
- Keyed padlock (medium-sized for lockout/tagout)
