Motion to adopt residential electric rate tiers as outlined on the Electric Rate Alternatives and Revenue Result Table option 7 and lower the high tier residential electric rate to \$1.09 effective January 1, 2020. Move/Corley, Second/Sommer. All ayes, Schad opposed.

Motion to adjust residential monthly electric rates with a target date of January 1, 2020 and then annually by 3% effective July 1, 2020 through July 1, 2024. Move/Hargrave, Second/Corley. All ayes. Motion carried unanimously.

Motion to combine the residential service charge and capital facility charge and increase commercial electric rates by 3% per year effective July 1, 2020 through July 1, 2024.

Move/Hargrave, Second/Corley. All ayes. Motion carried unanimously.
