PUBLIC HEARING OF OBJECTIONS held during the Special Meeting of Council held on December 18, 2018.

Mayor James called the Hearing of Objections Meeting to order at 6:10 p.m. reading aloud the Public Hearing Process.

Mayor James advised Council is in the process of revising the Rural Plan for the Municipality of Blacks Harbour pursuant to section 68 of the Community Planning Act, Council will now proceed with a Public Hearing to rezone a property bearing PID #15192586 (126-188 Deadmans Harbour Road) for 698474 NB Ltd./East Coast Atlantic Fisheries Ltd. currently zoned Rural to be zoned Industrial.

The Clerk indicated that there were no written submissions or registered speakers received for this issue.

Council agreed to hear guests if they wished to speak for or against the rezoning.

#### Comments:

- (1) Heather Chase of 110 Deadmans Harbour Road stated she was FOR the rezoning stating anytime we have a chance to diversify, economic development is a good thing, as it creates jobs. Only question was the buffer between the development, stating we have to look at the potential disruption to neighbouring properties.
- (2) Mary Deveau of 106 French Village Road stated she was FOR the rezoning but has concerns regarding the noise from blowers and generators needed to operate the facility
  - It was noted that there is approx. 500 metres from Deadmans Harbour Road and 300 metres from French Village Road residents
- (3) Morris Harris of 619 Wallace Cove Road stated he is FOR the rezoning stating his only concern was that if they transport shells that they be contained because of the smell.

All concerns were addressed by East Coast Atlantic Fisheries Ltd. representatives and contact information exchanged between parties, if they had any other concerns.

Mayor James stated what she was hearing was that the residents would like East Coast Atlantic Fisheries Ltd. to be good and considerate neighbours, to remember about noise and noise pollution and smells and should that become a problem, the company would be expected to remedy the problem.

Mayor James reminded residents that they may offer written submissions on this issue directly to the CAO and that they will be included with the final deliberation package. The deadline for written submissions is January 10, 2019.

The Public Hearing for By-law Z.1.3, "A By-law to Amend By-law Z.1, Village of Blacks Harbour Rural Plan" is now closed.
