REGULAR MEETING MINUTES  
MARCH 9,2021**

The Regular Meeting was called to order  
The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

**Present:** Mayor Dianne Dubberly, Vice Mayor Barbara Thomas, Councilman Anthony Kelley, Councilman Sheila Dubberly, Councilman Johnny Ho, Councilman Kyle Cheshire, Accountant Choi Choi and Town Clerk Lee Forzly. Attorney John Maines (via Teleconferenc).

Vice Mayor Thomas made the motion to approve the minutes from the regular meeting on March 9, 2021. Councilman Kelley seconded the motion. There was no discussion. Vote carried unanimously.

**Budget Report:** Accountant Choi Y Choi

Choi reported the revenues and expenses for General and Street funds were normal as usual. Choi then briefly discussed the expenses incurred for the fire department in regard to building maintenance, purchase of bunker gear, and uniforms. Lastly, Choi projected a \$15,000 deficit in payroll due to the significant increase of overtime. The cash balance for the General Fund \$87,082; Fire \$34,448; Street \$259,920; Money Market \$71,233; CD \$18,189 and WSPP \$74,291.

**Administering Oath of Office** – Seat Three Councilman Ho, Seat Four Councilman Thomas and Seat Five Councilman Kelley. Town Clerk administered the Oath of Office.

**New Business:**

**1.Mowing Contract 2021-2023**

The following bids were submitted to the council:

A.J Lawn Care \$9,800. Cassie's Lawn Care \$18,025. Swampcutter's \$15,200. Councilman Ho made the motion to approve A.J Lawn Care for \$9,800. Vice Mayor Thomas seconded the motion. After a discussion of the Workman's Compensation Exemption carried by AJ Lawn Care, the motion died for lack of support and Councilman Cheshire made the motion to approve Swampcutters, with full workman's compensation coverage. Councilman Kelley seconded the motion. The motion passed 4/1 with Councilman Ho opposing.

**2.Resolution 2021-01-** Adoption of Alachua County Local Mitigation Plan.

Vice Mayor Thomas made the motion to read by title only. Mayor Dubberly reads. Councilman Kelley seconded the motion. There was no discussion. Vote carried unanimously.

**Public Comments** — Concerns were expressed about the proposed closing of the CSX railroad crossing at NW 52nd Street and the stop sign located at the 3 way stop at NW 52cd St. and 207<sup>th</sup> Place.


**4. Parks and Recreation** — Councilman Cheshire nothing to report.


**5. Streets and Streetlights** - Councilman Ho — turned in outage report.
