America Ministries

Calvary Baptist Church supports thirteen different ministries based in America:

- Appalachian Miles for Smiles addresses dental/vision and other healthcare needs to the uninsured/under-insured folks in Upper East Tennessee and Southwest Virginia.

- Baptist Children's Homes (BCH) in North Carolina, provides Christian programs and services for children, mothers, and developmentally-disabled adults. It also serves frail and aging adults.

- The Bible Open Air Ministry (BOAM) is committed to reaching the lost of the world through open-air preaching. This ministry is based in New Jersey.

- Body and Soul Ministry operates in Belize (Central America). It serves the people's vision and dental needs with traveling medical teams in the ministry's free clinic. The Gospel is shared with the community.

- The Bible & Literature Missionary Foundation (BLMF) in Tennessee, is a faith-based printing ministry dedicated to printing the Word of God. Its mission is to provide a copy of God's Word for every needful person on the foreign mission field.

- Christ Is the Answer (CITA) Rescue Mission is in Melbourne, Florida. This organization gives relief to the homeless by providing food, shelter, and an opportunity of a personal relationship with Christ. CITA also has a shelter for women and children experiencing homelessness or domestic abuse. The shelter is called Helen's House.

- The Durham Rescue Mission in North Carolina provides food, clothing, housing, vocational training, Biblical counseling, job placement, education, and accountability to men, women, and children.

- Good News Jail and Prison Ministry reaches out to inmates, giving pastoral care and spiritual direction. In the Brevard County Jail, this ministry has Chaplain Darin Schoch, working with the inmates.

- The Local Church Bible Publishers in Michigan, is directed by Dr. John Green. This organization spreads the gospel and raises funds for printing Scripture portions, Bibles and New Testaments.

- Operation Christmas Child (OCC) headquartered in North Carolina, is a project of Samaritan's Purse. With OCC, our church packs gifts in shoe boxes. Samaritan's Purse sends these boxes to children worldwide.

- Our Daily Bread (ODB) in Michigan makes the Bible understandable and accessible to all.

- Sewing 4 Souls in West Virginia provides clothing to children throughout the world.

- Shepherds College in Wisconsin empowers young adults with disabilities to learn academically, socially, and professionally.
