

# Biography of District Deputy Grand Exalted Ruler of the San Gabriel Valley District Joanna Rentschler

Joanna Rentschler was born in Covina, California, on November 1, 1977. She graduated from San Dimas High School in 1995 and has worked for the Bassett Unified School District as a food service manager for twenty years. On April 28, 1999, Joanna became the third generation in her family to become an Elk when she joined Azusa Elks Lodge. For many of the 24 years that she has been an Elk, Joanna has served as a lodge officer, holding the positions of Tiler, Treasurer, Secretary, and served as Exalted Ruler during the 2005-2006 fraternal year. Over the years she was chair for many positions within her lodge including Drug Awareness, Hoop Shoot, Lodge Activities, Membership, Membership Retention, Elks Training, Elks National Foundation, and Piggy Bank. She assisted Azusa Lodge when moving and making its home in Pomona. When Pomona Lodge merged, she once again made the move and now makes her home in Duarte Lodge #1427. At the District level, Joanna has held Scouting and Bowling chairmanships. She has assisted in the District Scholarship judging. In 2010 and 2011 she assisted in judging Scholarship entries at the State Level. She has been the District PER Association Treasurer for the last 14 years. Joanna has assisted with the Annual District PER Picnic over the years. Joanna has also helped with various youth activities including the Americanism Essay contest, Hoop Shoot, Drug Awareness, and the Dictionary Project. She also held the position of CLMS chairman being appointed by the District Deputy at the time. Her role in this position was to ensure that every lodge in the San Gabriel Valley District transitioned smoothly to the Chicago Lodge Membership System. She still continues to assist several Lodges with any CLMS problems that may arise. Not only has Joanna assisted wherever she was wanted and needed within her District, but she has extended her talents to other Districts as well. She helps in the running of the Southeast District Bowling tournaments as well as assists with the Southern California Bowling tournament, which both raise substantial charitable monetary donations to our State Major Project. Joanna became a District Association Vice President under then State President, Hugh Scanlon in 2010-2011, and was one of his Lucky Charms. Joanna traveled to many lodges in various Districts to gain experience and learn even more about Elkdom. She served as District Deputy Grand Exalted Ruler for the first time in 2014-2015. Joanna comes from a family dedicated to Elkdom. Her father, James Rentschler, was a Past District Deputy Grand Exalted Ruler, her sister, Jennifer, is currently serving as Association Vice President for the San Gabriel Valley District, and her brother, JT, is a PER of Duarte Elks Lodge.




