We held a one-day camp at Camp Victory for those from the local drug rehabilitation center this past month and saw one man trust Christ as his Savior. Many more listened intently, and we are praying as we continue going there each Friday that we will see more come to know Christ.

We just finished with our campus ministry in the local high school as the school year is almost finished here. We were able to meet with approximately 230 students every Tuesday afternoon in 6 different classes and teach them lessons on "Knowing God". We are praying for the fruit from this ministry. Several of our members that are professors at the local colleges and schools have brought their students to church as well. Pray as we strive to reach these young lives.

We have a married couple that have been attending our church services since that night, and one of our newest members has been the one sitting with them and reaching out to them.
