

The Taylor Review – Modern Working Practices

A government sponsored report has been published into modern working practices in the United Kingdom with a view to making working practices fairer, and enhancing productivity in the workplace. There is also reference to enhancing the quality of work.

Due to the length of the report (116 pages), it would be difficult to provide a narrative on all the areas covered by the review, other than to say that it would require some far-reaching changes to UK Employment Legislation.

I would suggest that this is a 'must read' for employers, human resource professionals, employment agencies, and recruiters. It would also be of interest to employees, workers, the self-employed, and trade unions or other worker representatives.
