I Thessalonians 4:14-15 For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again, even so them also which sleep in Jesus will God bring with him. For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord, that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord shall not prevent them which are asleep.

Assurance Regarding Loved Ones

- 1. Faith in Christ's death and resurrection is the <u>core</u> of the Christian faith. For if we believe that Jesus died and rose again
- 2. Since Christ is risen from the dead, those who <u>die</u> in Christ will also be raised from the dead. *even so them also which sleep in Jesus*
- 3. God directly <u>oversees</u> the well-being of our departed loved ones.

will God bring with him

Truth #1: Faith in Christ's Resurrection

is faith in <u>our own</u> resurrection.

1. This truth is given by the <u>authority</u> of God's Word.

For this we say unto you by the word of the Lord

2. Believers should live <u>expecting</u> Christ to return in their lifetime. that we which are alive and remain unto the coming of the Lord

3. Those who are living at Christ's return will not have any <u>advantage</u> over those who have died. *shall not prevent them which are asleep*

<u>Truth #2</u>: Those who have died in Christ

will not have a <u>lesser</u> resurrection.
