Faith Calls for Perseverance Bible Background: Hebrews 10:19-31 Printed Text: Hebrews 10:19-31 KJV/NLT Devotional Reading: Romans 5:1-5

Aim for Change:

- 1. **KNOW** Jesus' sacrificial death opens the way to the presence of God
- 2. **FEEL** the importance of holding on to faith in Jesus
- 3. **SHARE** our faith with others

In Focus:

- How do you respond when are told no or rejected? *Matthew 21:33-44*
- Does your own guilt hinder/limit your access to Jesus? 1 Samuel 14:24-31

The People, Places, and Times:

- Holy of Holies associated with the presence of Yahweh, God
- **High Priest** the only one who could enter the Holy of Holies and only on the Day of Atonement
- Hebrews when Jewish Christians were both persecuted socially and physically by the Romans and Jews alike

Background:

- Mosaic Sacrifice OT sacrifices with animals, which were imperfect and could not completely purify and atone for the sins of the people *Deuteronomy 27*
- New Covenant Sacrifice NT sacrifice perfected by Jesus Christ, who shed His blood for our sins Mark 14:17-26

In Depth:

- 1. The Priesthood of Christ is Superior (Hebrews 10:19-21)
 - a. How has Jesus enabled us to enter into the Holy of Holies without being a high priest?
- 2. The Priesthood of Christ and Our Profession of Faith (Hebrews 10:22-25)
 - a. What have you professed about Jesus and when was the last time you did it? *Hebrews 3:1-15*
 - b. Is your life in Christ reflective in your attitude, action, and behavior? *Ephesians 5:25-30*
- 3. The Priesthood of Christ and Knowledge of the Truth (Hebrews 10:26-27)
 - a. Is your lack of spiritual growth caused rejecting the knowledge of the truth in Jesus? *Ephesians 1:13-14; 2 Thessalonians 2:6-14*
- 4. The Priesthood of Christ and How God Will Judge His People (Hebrews 10:28-31)
 - a. Are you confident where you stand in Jesus, when God's final judgment comes? *Wed: Galatians 2:15-21*

Application for Activation:

- When was the last time you volunteered your time, talent, and ability to please God? (i.e., church, sick and shut-in, outreach, etc.) 1 Corinthians 12:1-11
- When was the last time you have reached out to those who are on the rolls, but haven't been at church in a while? 1 Corinthians 12:12-26
