Remember that Pork-E-Que will be held on Sunday, March 15, 2020. Please make sure you join us for some great food, fun and music!

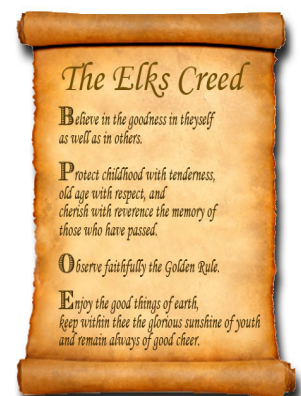
Tuesday, March 17, 2020 is St. Patrick's Day. Come and enjoy the corn beef and cabbage. It will be served from 5-7 p.m.
