

SWIMMING LESSONS

FOR PRESCHOOL & UP

Session 1 (13 weeks)

August 20-November 14

Fee: \$234

Session 2 (13 weeks) January 21 – April 24

The Quentin Road Instructors use a skill based program referencing the YMCA and the American Red Cross as guidelines for our swimming lessons.

Class size is limited to 4 to 1 for Preschool, and 6 to 1 for Kindergarten and up. We have a minimum of 2 Lifeguard Certified Instructors and an additional Lifeguard poolside at each lesson. If their swim lesson is during their scheduled school day, they will be accompanied to and from the pool area.

No Lessons the week of March 24 Due to limited space, sessions fill up quickly

30 minute lessons [plus 15 minutes before and after lesson to change & shower—no time to wash and dry hair] Tuesdays and Wednesdays 1pm–3pm Thursdays 1pm–4:15pm (3:30pm–4:30pm for Kind & Up only) Children need to be potty trained.
Absentees are not eligible for refunds or make up lessons. See www.grcp.org for details on swimming lesson skills

FOR 3 YEARS OLD-1ST GRADE (Limit 30)





INTRO TO TAEKWONDO

FOR PRESCHOOL CHILDREN (limit 15)

Taekwondo is not only fun for kids, but also a great full-body exercise which increases strength, coordination and flexibility! We are happy to have Ki Martial Arts coming to teach our classes. They will use age-appropriate games and drills to teach the children basic kicks, punches, blocks, forms, katas, stances and board breaking. Using these skills, they will also be teaching character bulding. Respect is taught not by scaring them into submission, which is often mistaken as respect, but actual respect. Respect for the knowledge and skill that the instructors can teach, for their friends that they spar with, and for the school that they attend. Self-discipline is taught by teaching children to wait their turn to make a comment or wait to talk to a friend, and to be able to listen attentively to someone who is teaching them.

INTRO TO PIANO MUSIC FOR LITTLE MOZARTS

Children will receive one-on-one instruction on the piano for 30 minutes each week with a piano recital in the Spring. Music for Little Mozarts was written for the preschool and kindergarten age groups. This curriculum provides a balance between the discipline necessary for playing the piano and the enjoyment one receives from the process of music making. The course centers on the adventures of Beethoven Bear and Mozart Mouse as they learn about music. Three correlating books (Music Lesson Book, Music Workbook and Music Discovery Book) guide the children through a comprehensive approach to musical learning, using the piano throughout the school year. 


