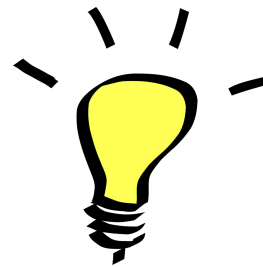


Things to Know for October!

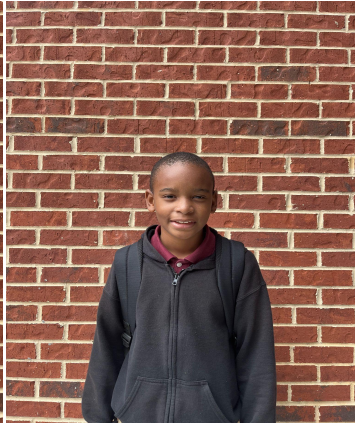
