MEMBER NEWS Back-to-back gains look possible

We are in the homestretch of the year—the final numbers for the 2022–2023 Lodge year will be recorded on March 31. We are projecting 88,000 Members will be added to the rolls with lower than average cancellations.

Our new Grand Lodge Billing System continues to grow with 671,000 invoices printed and mailed in January. The billing program has made it easier than ever for people to pay their dues. If this all pans out, we will be in a strong position for the first back-to-back gain in 43 years. Remember: All gas—no brakes!

Part of this success is owed to the membership tools available at elks.org and join.elks.org, which provide helpful, positive messages to reach out to new Members and retain the Members we have. However, growth in numbers doesn't come from any one special marketing trick. Instead, it reflects the way that Elks have made their Lodges attractive places for people to join.

We can achieve growth by continuing to be loud and proud about Elkdom, by ensuring that our Lodges are inviting to all visitors, and most importantly, by continuing to be the Best People On Earth.




