## I Peter 1:12 – Your Great Salvation, part 2

Unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.

## Your great salvation is received with great privilege.

1. Great wonders were <u>revealed</u> to Old Testament prophets.

Unto whom it was revealed. Isaiah 53:1, Daniel 2:19, Amos 3:7.

- 2. These wondrous prophecies were not for their own immediate <u>benefit</u>.

  that not unto themselves. Daniel 12:9, Hebrews 11:13.
- **3. Old Testament prophets** *ministered* **to us.** *but unto us they did minister the things.*
- **4.** The fulfillment of their prophecies are <u>declared</u> in the church age. which are now reported unto you.
- **5.** Gospel preachers declare in <u>detail</u> what the prophets foretold. by them that have preached the gospel unto you.
  - a. This declaration of details began with the Apostles.
  - b. It continues with every Gospel preacher and soulwinner.
  - c. These details are inherent in the Gospel message.
- **6.** The message of these preachers is <u>endorsed</u> by the Holy Ghost. with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven.
  - a. By the giving of the Holy Ghost. Acts 2:1-4.
  - **b. By the gifts of the Holy Ghost.** Romans 12:6-8.
  - c. By the power of the Holy Ghost. John 16:7-11.
- 7. The angels of God are <u>intrigued</u> by your salvation.

which things the angels desire to look into.

- It is an overwhelming privilege to be the <u>recipients</u> of God's salvation.
- See the 'big picture' of the wonders of your salvation.
- Don't allow yourself to have apathy towards such a precious treasure.
- Be a good <u>steward</u> of the glorious Gospel message.
