TODAY'S READINGS

First Reading — Before anything was created, the wisdom of God was brought forth (Proverbs 8:22-31).

Psalm — O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth! (Psalm 8).

Second Reading — God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us (Romans 5:1-5).

Brothers and Sisters,

Today we celebrate our belief in God, a threefold revelation of God the Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Three persons in one God. Easy to say, but difficult to understand, for it is a mystery beyond our comprehension. What we do know is that the Father (God) sent the Son (Jesus) to be united with humanity, to suffer with us, and to redeem us. Together the Father and Son sent the Holy Spirit (our advocate) to be with us always, guiding and sanctifying us. The Solemnity of the Trinity is an annual solemnity that is celebrated on the first Sunday after Pentecost and was extended to the universal church in 1334.



Some of the implications that we can see from today's solemnity are: 1) to check our way of praying we begin all our prayers with the sign of the cross. The greeting at the beginning of our Eucharistic celebration is Trinitarian: "The grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God the Father and the communion of the Holy Spirit...". 2) To check our way of looking at the sacraments: As baptized Christians, we are all adopted children of God the Father, brothers and sisters in Christ and temples of the Holy Spirit. 3) To check our relationship with God: it invites us to see who God is, to see what God does, to find out what God wants from us in return for what He has given us. Whenever we gather as a community of faith, we acknowledge and celebrate the life-giving relationship of Father to Son to Holy Spirit. Being in relationship is part of being human. Relationships give us strength and hope; they fuel us with love and support; they bless us with grace and life.

Our first reading from the book of Proverbs is probably the most theologically striking section of the book. Wisdom is personified as Lady Wisdom, who invites people to come to her to acquire prudence. She speaks of herself as a participant in the work of creation. She was an active agent. She foreshadows the divine intent to pour out God's own loving being on humanity: "I found delight in the human race" (Prv 8:31).

Today's reading from Paul's letter to the Romans was written toward the end of his third missionary journey. Paul captures divine self-giving to humanity through Christ in one word: *grace*. The Greek word *charis* which scripture translates as "grace" literally means "gift", and Paul uses it in his letters repeatedly to stress that human participation in divine life results entirely from God's own free initiative. The gift of grace is this: "the love of God has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit that has been given to us" (Rom 5:5).

The Holy Spirit was promised to be with the church for all time. That promise continues today. Jesus never abandoned us, not even at the moment of his death. The Holy Spirit was given to the church on Calvary when water and blood poured out of Jesus' side. Water was the outpouring of his Spirit upon a sorrowful world, and blood was the sign of his continued presence through the Eucharist.

The essential component of being in relationship with our Trinitarian God is to allow that relationship to impact all that we say and do. Our mission is to do for others what Jesus has done for us, in both his words and deeds, most especially in his loving outreach to all.



EL MISTERIO DE LA SANTÍSIMA TRINIDAD

PERCIBIR LO QUE NO SE VE

¿Alguna vez te has detenido en una noche despejada para mirar las estrellas, o te has tomado el tiempo para observar el esplendor de las flores de primavera, los colores cambiantes de las hojas de otoño o la belleza inmóvil de un paisaje cubierto de nieve? Esos momentos de reflexión silenciosa pueden llevarnos a un poderoso sentimiento de asombro. El mismo Dios que creó las estrellas, las flores, los árboles y la nieve nos creó a cada uno de nosotros. Al sentir la presencia de Dios en la belleza que nos rodea, podemos llenarnos de asombro al percibir lo que no se puede ver. Los momentos de asombro y admiración pueden tomarnos por sorpresa. Puede ser invisible, pero en esos momentos vemos la mano de Dios.

MIRAR CON OJOS DE FE

No sólo en la belleza de la creación de Dios sentimos la presencia del Señor. En los momentos de oración, especialmente en la celebración de la Eucaristía, nos fortalecemos en la fe para estar seguros del misterio del Dios trino. Por último, en el discurso de despedida del Evangelio de Juan, Jesús -que antes había hablado de sí mismo como el Hijo del Padre- promete a sus amigos que recibirán el Espíritu de la verdad que les enseñará y guiará después de que él se vaya.
