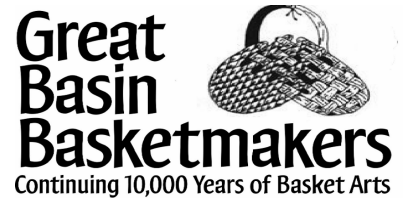


Presenter/Instructor Proposal —
