DATES: Competition—**Sunday, October 20, 2019**, beginning at 2 pm
Winners Concert—**Sunday, January 26, 2020**, at 4 pm

WHERE: Radke Fine Arts Theater, 2010 E Hurd, Edmond. On Campus of University of Central Oklahoma in Edmond. (*in Center for Transformative Learning, directly North of Community Parking Lot. Enter campus on Garland Godfrey Dr. at light on 2nd street*)

Prizes Offered:

- \$1,200.00—1st place Quartet
- \$600.00—2nd place Quartet
- \$200.00—3rd place Quartet

Repertoire required—Choose one selection from category A and one selection from category B

MAXIMUM PERFORMANCE TIME—15 MINUTES

1. All members of the String Quartet must be residents of Oklahoma and not older than the maximum age of 18 years by October 1, 2019
2. Quartets will play two selections; one from category **A** and one from category **B**.
3. Copies of music to be played by each quartet must be provided to each of the 4 judges.
4. During the competition, **NO** video or recording is allowed. No one, other than judges and CMOK staff, allowed in performance hall.
5. Quartets will perform on the stage of the Radke Performing Arts Theater. A separate warm-up room will be available.
6. Judges will select three String Quartet winners—1st, 2nd, 3rd place. Winners will be notified at the close of auditions on October 20. All applicants will be notified of the winners via email the following day.
- 7 All three winning quartets are *Required* to perform on the

Prizes will be awarded at that time.

8. Members of the three Winning Quartets will be introduced at the CMOK second concert of the 60th Anniversary Season, **Sunday, November 10, 2019**, at 4 pm at Christ the King Catholic Church, 8005 Dorset Dr. OKC. (*All students, their families and teachers have free admission to the concert.*)
9. Because Chamber Music In Oklahoma is a nonprofit organization and is required to comply with federal law regarding earnings reporting, **each** member of the three winning quartets must provide a Social Security or Tax ID number via IRS form W-9, available at:
