That week the song leader of the church in Abilene was in an accident, and a few days later the Lord took him home to heaven. Just a few days before we had been in his home, fellowshipping, and praising God in song. Within just a short time he was with the Lord. We stayed in Abilene for a couple of weeks and just helped out in the church. It was such a blessing to see several people come to know Christ, and follow in believers baptism during that time. We also had one of our supporting Pastor's suddenly pass away. Pastor Brown in Pembroke Pines, Fl suddenly collapsed and passed away. We have now raised 70% of our needed support, with a couple of churches that will be voting soon. The Lord also provided us with a new refrigerator for our motor home, and \$2000 toward our visas and plane tickets. God has blessed us abundantly! I was able to share the Gospel with an elderly gentleman, last week while out soul winning, but he did not make a decision to accept Christ. Please pray that Mr. Stars will read the tract, and make that decision before it's too late.
