

### **Community Spiritual Director**

So we've all been in a service where the leader says, "God is good!" and we know the appropriate response is "All the time!" However, quite often we hear or see the question, "If God is good, why is there so much evil in the world?" As I write this I have been watching scenes unfold of devastation in eastern Kentucky. Wildfires are raging in large parts of the western US. Tornados have destroyed property and lives in many parts of our nation. Mass shootings are becoming more and more frequent and seemingly more widespread. So how do we who believe God truly in good all the time answer the questions of the doubters? The Word tells us that God will protect his people.

In Psalm 85:8 we are told that "he promises peace to his people, his faithful servants." And yet, we struggle. I believe the answers are many and for me to try to address this issue completely in this article is not feasible.

However, one part of this is to remember that we believe God is good, not that the world is good. The fact is that Scripture tells us that no one is good.

It would seem to me that more and more people are relying on their own goodness rather than the goodness of God. I've presided over too many funerals where family and friends tell me what a good person the deceased was. More and more people are walking away from the church. More and more people are claiming no religious affiliation. We have as a nation seemingly decided that God's protection, the peace he promises in Psalm 85, is not necessary. As we turn away from him the world takes over and bad things begin to happen. The problem seems overwhelming and we just don't know where to turn.

I have one suggestion. Why not sponsor someone for the fall walks? These walks are designed to strengthen the church. As the church is strengthened more people begin to realize that our need for God is priority one. It doesn't seem like much but if each of us can help one person see the love of God, perhaps for the first time ever, the Body of Christ will begin to grow. Time is short. We need to take action now. Who do you know that can benefit from the Walk to Emmaus? Let's not let the world influence us, let's influence the world.
