ORDER

WHEREAS on January 11, 2012, the New Brunswick Securities Commission issued a temporary Order prohibiting the Respondent Donat Robichaud Residence Inc. from trading in securities and stipulating that any exemptions under New Brunswick securities law do not apply to the Respondent Donat Robichaud Residence Inc.;

WHEREAS on January 11, 2012, the New Brunswick Securities Commission issued a temporary Order stipulating that any exemptions under New Brunswick securities law do not apply to the Respondent Larry Hurley;

WHEREAS as of July 1, 2013, the New Brunswick Securities Commission is continued as the Financial and Consumer Services Commission and the adjudicative functions of the New Brunswick Securities Commission are now performed by the Financial and Consumer Services Tribunal;

WHEREAS in accordance with section 75 of the *Financial and Consumer Services Commission Act*, S.N.B. 2013, c 30, decisions issued by the New Brunswick Securities Commission in this proceeding are deemed to be those of the Financial and Consumer Services Tribunal;

WHEREAS on July 17, 2015, the Financial and Consumer Services Commission filed two Notices of discontinuance advising that it was discontinuing the proceedings against the Respondent Larry Hurley and the Respondent Donat Robichaud Residence Inc.;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The temporary Order dated January 11, 2012 against the Respondent Larry Hurley is hereby vacated;
2. The temporary Order dated January 11, 2012 against the Respondent Donat Robichaud Residence Inc. is hereby vacated; and
3. This proceeding continues as against the Respondent Charline Hurley.
