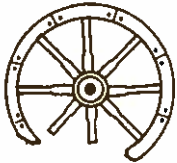

**No.2021-49** Approve the building permit of 5 Star Tire to add a canopy item was tabled.


**No.2021-50** Financial statements and bills for February 2021 by councilman Havard on motion by Frank Havard seconded by Michael Gremillion unanimously adopted.
