a loved ones touch.

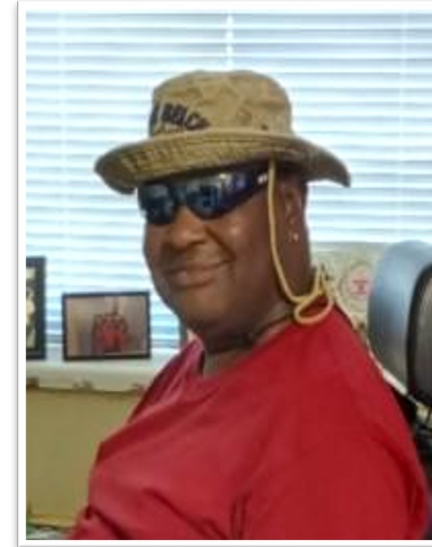
Perhaps my life seemed all too brief:
