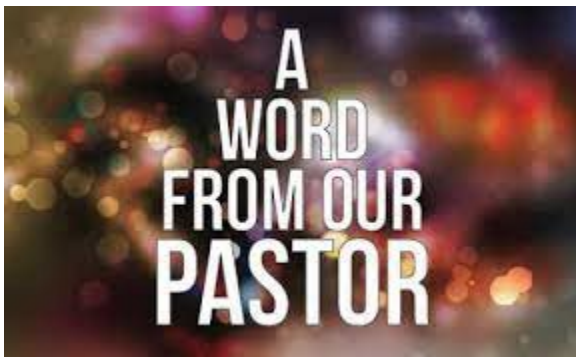


Camp Eder...Summer is just around the corner. Wondering how to further your children's walk with God and keep them focused on Him and less on all the digital gadgets and worldly ideas.
