Obituary

Evangelist Alice Oretha Baldwin Riley was born September 17, 1950 in Winston-Salem, North Carolina to the late Myrtle L. Baldwin and James Dennis Baldwin. She departed this life on April 23, 2026 at her home. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her brother, Raymond Denard Lowery and her sister, Vicki Baldwin Anthony.

Evangelist Riley received Jesus Christ at a very early age when she asked Him to be her daddy at the age of five. She began then developing her relationship with Jesus while a member of Friendship Baptist Church under the pastorate of Reverend S. E. Tyndall. Later Alice moved to Davie County and became an licensed Evangelist under the pastorate of Reverend Melvin Kelser of New Shepherd Baptist Church in Cooleemee, North Carolina. She then became a member of Redeemed Missionary Baptist Church where she served under the current Pastor, Rev. Gary B. Later, she received her Paralegal Associate Degree from Davie County Community College. Alice co-founded Mothers Helper, Inc. and later founded Babe Speaks, Inc. to assist mothers with special needs babies.
