VACANCY FOR LOWER BIG BLUE NRD DIRECTOR

The Lower Big Blue Natural Resources District is accepting applications to fill a vacancy on its board. A director is needed for the unexpired term for Sub-district Six in Beatrice. This area includes voting Ward 1 of the corporate limits of the City of Beatrice. All of Ward 2 except a portion between Washington and Summit Streets between Seventh and Eleventh Streets of the corporate limits of the City of Beatrice. A part of Ward 3 between Scott and High Streets between Eighth and Ninth Streets and a portion between High and Grant Streets between Seventh and Ninth Streets.

To be eligible for this position, the applicant must reside in Sub-district Six and be a registered voter. This term will expire in January of 2022. The vacancy exists because the former director, Doug Pieper has moved out of the Sub-district. Doug had served on the NRD board since 2013.

The thirteen directors of the district determine programs and projects for flood control, groundwater quality, groundwater quantity, soil and water conservation, public recreation, tree planting, and fish and wildlife habitat. Directors receive a per diem for each meeting they attend and are reimbursed for actual expenses incurred while on official NRD business. The board meets monthly on the last Thursday of the month in Beatrice.
