

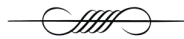
**If We Could Bring You Back Again**

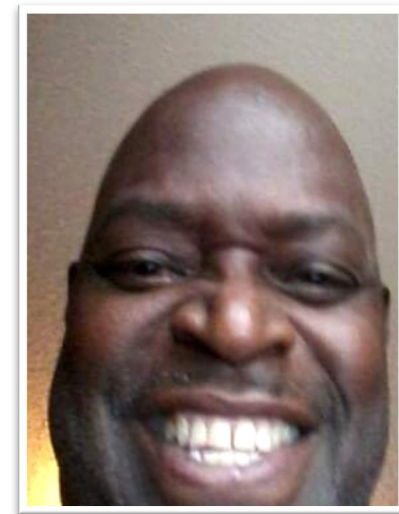

## Obituary

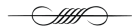
