IMPORTANT NOTICE

Squads are scheduled 1-hour and 30-minutes apart. Please keep the shoot on time by arriving at your field 15 minutes prior to scheduled time. Shooter taking more than the allotted NSSA 1:30 could be moved to a different field to continue their shooting.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. This shoot is registered with and will be conducted in accordance with the rules of the NSSA.
2. Flight times and shooting fields will be rotated to ensure fairness to all shooters. All events will be shot 100 targets per field.
3. Classification will be based on 2026 NSSA rules. It is the shooter's responsibility to present a classification card that contains a complete and accurate record of scores, averages, and classes.
4. Preference in squadding reservations will be given to 5 person squads shooting both 12 and 20 gauge and then shooters shooting a single event. Requests for reservations must not be postmarked or sent via mail or email earlier than April 13th, 2026. No requests for reservations will be processed until the week of April 20th, when they will be processed by order of postmark date or email received.
5. Confirmations will be e-mailed starting the week of April 20th and will continue as registrations are received.
6. The club will provide shoot-off targets at its own expense, but shoot-off ammunition will be at the shooter's expense.
7. Shoot-off doubles shall be shot under "NSSA doubles rules" and all malfunction rules shall be suspended. All class places will be shot off.
8. Shoot-off's for Champions and class winners will establish Concurrent places where possible; shoot offs will be shot off by doubles from stations 3, 4 and 5, total team score by station, and shall be shot off subsequent to the gauge event.
9. Winners for 12- and 20-gauge events will be announced at the End of Day Saturday.
10. Winnings for all events will be completed within 2 weeks of the shoot's completion. Contestants and spectators assume all risks of theft and/or accidents.
11. Eye and ear protection is mandatory on or near the fields.
12. Fees per 100 targets: NSSA, \$4.00, CSSA, \$2.00
13. CSSA Directors and Fin, Fur & Feather reserve the right to suspend or alter the program if conditions so warrant, and to refuse entry, or cause the withdrawal of, any shooter for any reason they deem proper.

Winner Payouts

AWARDS

Shoot Management will report class and concurrent honors as required by All-American Committee guidelines.

SHOOT-OFF

All ties shall be decided by doubles from stations 3, 4 and 5, miss and out by station. Concurrent event championships may be shot off concurrently with Gun Championship if possible.

12-GAUGE CHAMPIONSHIP

100 Targets – May 23rd, 2026
6 Classes (AA through E)

EVENT #2

20-GAUGE CHAMPIONSHIP

100 Targets – Saturday, May 23rd, 2026
5 classes (AA through D)

FLIGHTS: 1:00pm, 2:30pm

EVENT #3

HIGH OVERALL CHAMPIONSHIP

200 Targets -- Total of Events #1 and 2.

HOA classification will be based upon shooter's four-gun average calculated at the time of last re-classification.

Shooters must be classified in all four guns to enter.

Unclassified shooters may enter AA class.

CONCURRENT EVENTS

All concurrent events will be available at the Northeast Open, at no charge.

AWARDS

Medals will be determined by CSSA

DEFINITIONS

Sub-Junior: any person who has not reached their 14th birthday

Junior: any person who has not reached their 18th birthday

Triple-Sub Senior: any person between ages 18 and 39

Sub-Sub Senior: any person who has reached their 40th birthday

Sub-Senior: any person who has reached their 50th birthday

Senior: any person who has reached their 60th birthday

Veteran: any person who has reached their 70th birthday

Senior Veteran: any person who has reached their 80th birthday

NOTES

1. No contestant shall be eligible for more than one concurrent event based on age.
 2. A contestant entering a concurrent event based on age must shoot in the event for which they are qualified (e.g., a senior may not enter as a sub-senior).
 3. The contestant's age on November 1 shall determine their eligibility to enter events based on age for the entire shooting year (NSSA Rules).
