Camp Dress Code

Girls:

1. No pants, tank tops or halter tops are allowed.
2. For game time ladies can wear Baggy Basket-ball Shorts (they must come to the knee). Culottes are allowed, and must be true culottes, no walking shorts, etc. All dresses and skirts must be knee-length. One-piece bathing suit with shirt and shorts required for swimming
3. No blouse or top will be allowed that is low cut No tight-fitting clothes will be allowed
4. T-Shirts are allowed, but must not advertise worldly advertisement, for example rock music, alcohol, and movie stars, tobacco products, etc.
5. In the evening services, girls please dress as you would for a Sunday morning church service; for morning services, a more casual dress will be allowed.
6. Shoes, sandals, and/or tennis shoes, must be worn at all times.

Boys:

1. Baggy Basketball Shorts allowed for game time.
2. Jeans and light-weight pants are allowed
3. No jogging or sweat pants will be allowed except in the dorms .Shorts and shirt required for swimming.
4. No tank tops. T-shirts can be worn, but must not advertise worldly advertisement, for example rock music, alcohol, and movie stars, tobacco products...
5. No earrings or necklaces are allowed.
