### Genesis 2:7-14

Sis. Karie Ferguson is our missionary to the Côte d'Ivoire (Ivory Coast), located on the Gulf of Guinea in West Africa. She lives in the city of Abidjan, the third capital of Côte d'Ivoire, following Grand-Bassam and Bingerville. Sis. Karie works alongside the Mach missionary family, and Christian nurse practitioner, Kristine McLaughlin. She helps in 3 church plants started by the Machs: one in Bingerville, another in the far north village of Zanaplédougou, and in a church in the city of Man. Besides the church services, a Christian elementary school has started in Bingerville and a medical clinic ministry in the Zanaplédougou church. In Sis. Karie's last correspondence (Dec 2023), she mentioned that they were also starting a ministry, the Williams Bible Club, to help children with developmental disabilities. Currently, the Bible Club has four students with special needs.

Sis. Karie request prayer for her health, vehicle needs, her Dad's health, salvation for neighbor, family, and friend, Abiba.
