## Bible Background: Revelation 22:1-7 Printed Text: Revelation 22:1-7 KJV/NLT

**Devotional Reading: Genesis 1:1-13** 

### Aim for Change (Page 584):

- 1. **RESEARCH** the biblical references to the "river of life" to learn its spiritual, symbolic, and material effect on creation **Psalm 46:4**; **Isaiah 43:2**; **Ezekiel 47:9**; **Tue: Zechariah 14:8**; **Fri: John 7:37-40**
- 2. *IMAGINE* God's provisions to be found in the river of life, which will nourish and heal people and nations in the New Jerusalem
- 3. **RESPOND** to the river of life through acceptance, faith, and entrance into the fullness of God's kingdom

### In Focus (Page 584):

• What is the thing you most look forward to in God's new heaven and new earth?

# The People, Places, and Times (Page 586):

- **Lamb** symbolic reference to Christ that unites redemption/kingship and victorious power and vicarious suffering
  - o Lamb that has been slain Revelation 5:6, 12
  - o Their robes washed by the blood of the Lamb *Revelation 7:14*
  - Overcome the enemy by the blood of the Lamb *Revelation 12:11*
  - o The Lamb has the power to take the book and loose its seals *Revelation 5:6-7*
  - The wrath of the Lamb *Revelation 6:16*
  - O The Lamb in the midst of the throne Revelation 7:17

- 1. God's Glorious People (Revelation 22:1-2)
  - a. In what ways might the tree of life be used "for healing the nations"? Wed/Thu: John 4:4-26
  - b. Is your personal dam (sin) blocking the flow of God's River in your life? *Proverbs 8:33*; *Ezekiel 47:12*; *Hosea 9:17*
  - c. What are you doing with your tree? Wisdom *Proverbs 3:18*; The fruit of righteousness *Proverbs 11:30*; Fulfilled desire *Proverbs 13:12*; A wholesome tongue *Proverbs 15:4*
- 2. God's Glorious Presence (Revelation 22:3-5)
  - a. Jesus is the light of the world, and of heaven. How have you seen His light in your life? *John* 3:19-20; 1 Corinthians 15:51-54
  - b. Are you being a light in other's darkness? *Ephesians 5:8; 1 John 1:7*
- 3. God's Glorious Promise (Revelation 22:6-7)
  - a. How do we know that God's words are trustworthy and true? *Matthew 5:3-12; Luke 1:70; Revelation 1:1*

### Discuss the Meaning (Page 588):

- 1. What did God mean by saying these things "must shortly be done" when this was recorded so long ago? *Revelation 22:6*
- 2. Why is it often hard to have a true longing for heaven?

- How do you respond when you feel slighted?
- Does a focus on making things right in this world keep you from longing for the next?
