The Lodge has been awarded the \$2000 Spotlight Grant, which it will use to make a \$1000 donation to the YWCA-San Gabriel Valley in support of their home delivery of 270 lunches to senior citizens in the West Covina, Baldwin Park, Covina and La Puente communities. The additional \$1000 will be used by the Lodge to create Neighbor to Neighbor care packages of items to be delivered at the same time as the lunches. How can you help? By donating and bringing to the lodge by August 1, 2020, items such as small bottles of liquid hand soap or hand sanitizer, boxes of facial tissues, individual rolls of paper towels, word search books, small bags of snacks, sugar free candies. (Please include your receipt for your purchases.) Or by sending a monetary donation of any denomination to the Lodge and identifying it to be used for the Spotlight Grant. Or volunteering to come to the Lodge to create the care packages and/or volunteering to help with their delivery tentatively scheduled for the week of August 17. Interested? The fourth grant the Lodge has also been awarded is the \$2500 Freedom Grant which the Lodge will be donating in full to the Long Beach VA's Women's Closet, overseen by the Women Veterans Programs and Voluntary Services. They will use the funds to stock the Closet with items such as undergarments, socks, pajamas, jackets, shoes and job interview appropriate clothing. These items will be gifted to homeless and poverty-level women veterans who have been referred by a provider or social worker. How can you help? This is a special notice to advise all Lodge members that on Tuesday, July 14th at our regular Lodge Meeting, there will be a special vote conducted for the transfer of funds from our Restricted Money Market Account to our Operating Account.

The Lodge has been been operating on a skeleton budget due to the the COVID-19 pandemic which forced the closure of our Lodge. Our lodge financial situation will not get any better without a steady stream of income. Due to this outlook, the Board of Trustees will bring to the membership at our next open meeting, a request for \$60,000.00 from the Lodge's restricted money market account. This money will cover all outstanding bills, property taxes, refund any lease out/rental deposits from canceled hall rentals that could not be rescheduled, and to assist the Lodge with expenses that will be incurred during the initial re-opening process of the Lodge.

We invite all members to join the floor discussion and come out to vote on this important matter. We look forward to your support.




