Fanny J. Crosby (1820-1915) was the author of over 8,500 gospel songs. Though blind at 6 weeks of age,



Crosby began composing texts at age 6. Once she was asked, "Is there a special hymn written for your conversion experience?" Fanny replied, "I would write many hymns to describe the joy of my salvation. The one that stands out the most to me right now is this one." She began to sing in her beautiful soprano voice, "redeemed, how I love to proclaim it."

Two scriptures come to mind related to her hymn, **Redeemed.**

1 Peter 1.18-19 "For you know that it was not with perishable things such as silver or gold that you were **redeemed** from the empty way of life handed down to you from your forefathers, but with the precious blood of Christ, a lamb without blemish or defect.

Psalm 107.1-2a "Give thanks to the LORD, for he is good; his love endures forever. Let the **redeemed** of the LORD say this..."


