## Walk in Wisdom - Ephesians 5:15-17

How Christians walk day by day throughout life is crucial to the cause of Christ. Here's the premise of what Paul is getting at tonight: *Those who walk carefully do not walk foolishly, like an unwise person.*

Walk in – vs. 17 'Wherefore be ye not unwise, but understanding what the will of the Lord is,'
When we think of God's will, we often think of it in the sense of a career choice or opportunity. Paul is referring to God's already <b>revealed will</b> .  What is God's already revealed will?
Understand means to grasp or perceive, to see with the mind and comprehend.  Understanding God's will means to our lives after Jesus.

Key Truth: Embracing what is
Core Truth: Walking in Wisdom means what is valuable, and what is best. The theology of Gospel living should reflect <i>authentic</i> Gospel living.
