"Sun is Rising" - Lyrical

Costume: Peach Lace Dress (long sleeve on the left, strap on the right)
Tights: Suntan Tights
Shoes: Tan Jazz Shoes
Hair: Low bun parted in the middle.
Accessories: Hair barrette to be worn on the right side of the head, secured with bobby pins.

"Good To Go" – Tap

Costume: Purple Iridescent Sequin Dress
Tights: Suntan Tights
Shoes: Tan Tap Shoes
Hair: Low bun parted in the middle.
Accessories: Hair barrette to be worn on the right side of the head, secured with bobby pins.

GENERAL COSTUME NOTES:

- Please label ALL pieces of your child's costume. Including tights and shoes!
- NO underwear. NO jewelry. NO nail polish.
- Hairnets must be used for those who will wear a bun for the revue. A bun hairstyle requires multiple bobby pins and hair gel/spray to maintain a tidy bun. For girls with shorter hair a 'donut' may be used to create a bun. Please watch this video for ways to make a good bun. http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=882m4QKu0sg&feature=em-share_video_user
- Makeup should be applied heavily due to lighting. Browns, plums, and pinks look best from stage.
- Please make sure that bows on ballet shoes are tucked in and that there are NO bows on your child's tap shoes (jazz tap shoestrings acceptable). If they are patent leather-they must be changed to black elastic.
- You may contact this class's costume contact mom (at the top of this page) with any questions you have regarding your child's costume.

Class Picture Time: Saturday, March 28th - 11:00 am

Please arrive at least 10 minutes prior to the scheduled time. Arrive in regular DANCE ATTIRE to take the class picture. Hair for all pictures can be styled differently than how it will be worn on Revue day. Individual costume pictures will be taken after the class picture, the small room will be available for you to change your child into her costumes. Boys can use the restrooms to change into their costumes.
