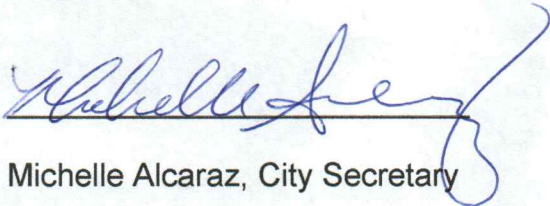
J. Council to consider, discuss, and take action on designating use of city-owned vehicles.
