MUSIC SYNCHRONOUS ONLINE LEARNING:

TK-Kindergarten Music

Children are born with musical abilities that should be developed as early as possible. St. Catherine of Alexandria's first aim in music education is to instill a love of music in every child. We believe by exposing students at a young age, they are able to build capacities that closely link development in other curriculum areas like language, reading, writing and mathematics. Tk-K grade levels will meet one time a week for 30 minutes. Materials needed 4 pieces musical hand percussion instrument set, includes 1 Pair 8 inch rhythm sticks wood claves and 1 pair wood egg shaker.

1st-3rd Grade Music Recorders

Learning to play recorders as their first instrument makes it easier for students to tackle more challenging wind instruments in concert band (4th and up). Playing the recorder introduces students to a new, universal language of music which includes: reading rhythms, music notes, music notation and other skills that can be used for the rest of their lives. 1st and 2nd graders will meet 2 times a week combined. 3rd graders will meets 2 times a week for 30 minutes each plus 1 day of 40 minutes of tutoring a week.

4th Grade Beginning Band

Fourth grade band students are able to choose a wind or percussion instrument. Instruments of choice are Flute, Clarinet, Alto Sax, French Horn, Trumpet, Trombone, Electric Bass Guitar, Xylophone or Percussion. They have an option to rent/buy their own instrument or borrow from a few lender instrument the school owns. This year will be an introduction of caring for and putting together their instruments. Students will also learn to read notation, theory and rhythms corresponding to their new instrument of choice. Materials need will be "Standard Of Excellence" book one, color red. They will begin their journey of their personal voice through instruments and their first steps towards achieving the many personal benefits of plaving a musical instrument. Beginning band will meet 2 times a week for 30 minutes a day plus 4 times of 40 mins each split section classes of tutoring with combined 5th graders.

5th Grade Second Year Beginning Band

Second year beginning band is a continuation of the fundamental skills learned in the fourth grade. Students will be introduced to more challenging notes, music notation, theory, rhythms, harmony and songs. They will be expected to play more independent melodies and rhythms simultaneously, as well as together as an ensemble. They will continue on their "Standard Of Excellence" Book one, color red. Fifth grade meets 2 times a week for 30 minutes a day plus 4 times of 40 mins each split section classes of tutoring with combined 5th graders.

6th-8th Grade Concert Band and Choir

Grades 6th-8th will have the choice to continue with concert band online or begin choir/theory/music appreciation. All 6th-8th graders that choose choir/theory/music appreciation will meet twice a week with their respective grade level only for 30 minutes a day. Students will be exposed to more artist, songs, theory, rhythms. All other materials will be posted on google classroom. All 6th-8th graders that choose band will be exposed to group/individual tutoring 6 times of 40 mins each in split section classes. Materials expected for 6th-8th grade concert band students will be "Standard Of Excellence" book one color red or book two color blue. All other materials will be posted on google classroom. This group will be a stepping stone for all 6th-8th grade students to move into challenging music repertoire for their personal musical growth.
