Costume-Tights-Shoes-Hair-Accessoriesrose leotard suntan stirrup tan pirouette low bun middle part hair piece to be worn on left side of bun



### <u>"Fashionista" – Jazz</u>

Costume-	Blue unitard clips at back of neck. Be sure to safety pin to ensure it stays.
Tights-	Suntan footed
Shoes-	tan jazz
Hair-	low bun middle part
Accessories-	none

#### **GENERAL COSTUME NOTES:**

- Please label ALL pieces of your child's costume. Including tights and shoes!
- NO underwear. NO jewelry. NO nail polish.
- Hairnets must be used for those who will wear a bun for the revue. A bun hairstyle requires multiple bobby pins and hair gel/spray to maintain a tidy bun. For girls with shorter hair a 'donut' may be used to create a bun. - Makeup should be applied heavily due to lighting. Browns, plums, and pinks look best from stage.
- Please make sure that bows on ballet shoes are tucked in and that there are NO bows on your child's tap shoes (jazz tap shoestrings acceptable). If they are patent leather-they must be changed to black elastic.
- You may contact this class's costume contact mom (at the top of this page) with any questions you have regarding your child's costume.

Please arrive at least 10 minutes prior to the scheduled time. Arrive in regular **DANCE ATTIRE** to take the class picture.
