From The Community Lay Director

I recently had the privilege of doing Team Orientation for the Fall Men's Team. It is such a blessing to meet with these men as they begin the work of team formation and begin the process of what I believe is a binding together as a part of the Body of Christ. It gives a whole new meaning to the song, "Bind Us Together, Lord!" And is this not truly our prayer as these men work under God's directions to provide the experience of the Walk to Emmaus to the pilgrims?

It is also time for the LOVE Community to begin preparations for the Fall Men and Women Walks! Our first duty is prayer. As we come to God in prayer, ask specifically that His will be done in the Fall Walks, that each team is bound together "with cords that cannot be broken," and that the Pilgrims He wants us to minister to through the Walks are invited, sponsored, and prayed over in the next few weeks. Prayer before, during, and after is such an important part of these Walks, and very much one of the responsibilities of the Community!

Another important responsibility of the Community is to be obedient in inviting and sponsoring the Pilgrims He puts on our hearts. The reason Emmaus works through "sponsors" is to emphasize the importance of relationship, relationship to God and relationship to our brothers and sisters in Christ. The act of sponsoring brings a new facet to both of these relationships. We draw closer to God as we pray about potential Pilgrims and seek His will in inviting and sponsoring them. We also draw closer to the Pilgrim as we pray for them and their family before, during, and after the Walk. We ask the Pilgrim to trust us in sponsoring them for the Walk, to trust us that the experience of the Walk is worth their time, and giving this trust takes the relationship to a new level. And, finally, the shared experience of the Walk and subsequent Fourth Days will bless the relationship for eternity.

If you have never sponsored a Pilgrim, I encourage you to pray for God's guidance and direction to do so. It will be a tremendous blessing to both you and your Pilgrim! DeColores! Linda Naylor

From The Spiritual Director

Once again it is time to think about upcoming Emmaus Walks. Teams have been formed and meetings have begun. Now what we need is pilgrims.

While preparing an upcoming sermon, I read the following true story, and it reminded me of the spiritual condition of many and perhaps those who God wants on the upcoming walks.

During the depression there was a sheep ranch owned by a man named Mr. Yates. Mr. Yates wasn't able to make enough on his ranching operation to pay the capital and interest on the mortgage, so he was in danger of losing his ranch.

With little money for clothes or food, his family (like many others) had to live on government subsidy. Day after day, as he grazed his sheep over those rolling West Texas hills, he was greatly troubled about how he would pay his bills.

Then a seismographic crew from an oil company came into the area and told him there might be oil on his land. They asked permission to drill a wildcat well, and he signed a lease contract.

At 1,115 feet they struck a huge oil reserve. The first well came in at 80,000 barrels a day. Many subsequent wells were more than twice as large. In fact, 30 years after the discovery, a government test of one of the wells showed it still had the potential flow of 125,000 barrels of oil a day.

And Mr. Yates owned it all. The day he purchased the land, he had received the oil and mineral rights. Yet he had been living on handouts, a multimillionaire living in poverty. And the problem--he didn't know the oil was there even though he owned it.

Many Christians live in spiritual poverty because of spiritual ignorance. They are entitled to the gifts of the Holy Spirit and His energizing power, but they are not aware of their birthright.

While there are many ways we can learn of the depth of our Christian birthright, The Walk to Emmaus is one of the more enlightening ways, packed into 72 hours of Biblical revelation.

Yet we members of the Emmaus community are aware of the riches God wants to share, but we are reluctant to invite pilgrims to a 72 hour crash course on God's riches.

How many "Mr. Yates" are out there--spiritual millionaires, but unaware of their wealth because they have never been informed?

SCHEDULE OF WEEKEND EVENTS/NEEDS

AGAPE is <u>needed please</u>! If you have Agape, please try to get it to the Walk by Friday morning so the Logs have time to get it sorted (60 pieces for everyone; 30 if only for Pilgrims). Sponsors, be sure and get your Pilgrim's letters to the Logs by Saturday evening. And, just in case you weren't aware, Team members <u>appreciate</u> getting Agape cards and letters, too!! If you have questions about Agape or need delivery service to Ruggles contact Bill Boling, our Agape Chairperson at 937-515-7370.

<u>Thursday</u>: Sponsors, please have your Pilgrim at Ruggles by 6:00 p.m. Community, please come out and welcome the Pilgrims at the send-off picnic (meal at 6:30). Bring your favorite covered dish and/or soft drink (meat is provided) AND if you arrive a little early, you can: carry some luggage, make a bed or two, clear some tables, smile at a nervous Pilgrim, pray for the Pilgrims and Team - just as it was done for you! And please plan to stay for Sponsor's Hour so you can pray for our Team and Pilgrims by name and share in a time of worship and Holy Communion together.

<u>Saturday</u>: The Community Service starts at <u>8:00 p.m.</u> - Remember to arrive (<u>and leave</u>) quietly so that we do not distract the Pilgrims. Please come out to worship together and to support our men/women in prayer.

Sunday: Closing - please meet in the Dining Hall by <u>3:30 p.m.</u> You won't want to miss the blessing of hearing the Pilgrims' testimonies!

<u>Pilgrims & Team:</u> Please be in prayer for the men/women who are scheduled to attend the Walk and for the Team. Watch your email Thursday night for the updated list after the Walk begins.

Please be Considerate: Finally, just a little reminder that, in order to attend or participate in the Community Walk events a person <u>must</u> have already been on the Walk to Emmaus or Chrysalis. And because these events - especially the Candlelight and Closing services - are so special for our Pilgrims, children should <u>not</u> attend. It's important that we remember to be considerate of <u>all</u> the Pilgrims.

Some of the key points as a Sponsor, Application, get the application to the pilgrim. Information, give the pilgrim the information needed to prepare for the walk. Get the personal letters (have family and close friends place a star or asterisk on the outside of the envelope.) Get your pilgrim to the kickoff picnic and attend sponsors hour. The most important part of being a sponsor is prayer. Pray for your pilgrim even before you ask them. Then support get them there and prepare to get them home. If possible attend candlelight. As we all know when you are walking through there and seeing your sponsor makes a differences. Finally attend the closing and support. We are counting on you to understand and fulfill the responsibilities of a Sponsor. These include:

<u>AWARENESS</u> AND **SENSITIVITY** - sponsor only those you know well enough to assess their spiritual, physical, and emotional readiness for the Walk.

PREPARATION - you are to inform the pilgrim (and spouse) of the nature and schedule of the Walk and the opportunity for ongoing Emmaus participation, share groups and gatherings. REMEMBER, NO SECRETS, ONLY SURPRISES.

SUPPORT - you are asked to support your pilgrim with transportation to and from the Walk, prayer vigil during the Walk, personal agape, attendance at Sponsor's Hour, Candlelight and Closing, escort to their first monthly gathering and assistance in finding a sharing group. Help with family needs during the weekend if so desired. Commit yourself to minimal contact with your pilgrim on the Walk, especially if it is your spouse.
