### Aim for Change (Page 374):

## In Depth (Pages 377-378):

- 1. Women at the Tomb (Matthew 28:1-8)
  - a. Have you ever heard the voice of an angel and/or God and didn't listen out of fear of not knowing whose voice it was? (*Judges 6:9-10*; Proverbs 4:20-27; *John 10:3-5*)
- 2. Jesus Appears to the Women (*Matthew 28:9-10*)
  - a. How has fear stopped you from sharing the Gospel in the past? What can you do to overcome that fear? (*Saturday Psalm 118:14-17, 19-29*)

## **Search the Scriptures (Page 378):**

- 1. What four messages did the angel give the women? (Matthew 28:5-7)
- 2. What emotions did the women express upon receiving the call to carry the Good News of the risen Lord? (Matthew 28:8)

## Discuss the Meaning (Page 378):

- 1. What does Jesus' resurrection mean for believers everywhere? For sinners everywhere? For evil and death? (*John 5:38-40*; *10:27-29*)
- 2. Why is it important for believers to share the Good News of Jesus' resurrection? (*Matthew 28:16-20*)

## **Liberating Lesson (Page 378):**

1. How can we be bolder to share the Good News when people may question the power of God to challenge our expectations and transform our lives? (*Ephesians 3:11-13*)
